2023 was a year of growing food insecurity in our community. We served many new families struggling with knowing where their next meal is coming from and how to stretch their limited food budgets each month.

Together, we work to collect food donations from 12 grocery stores each week through our partnership with the Idaho Food Bank and Feeding America; donate our time, money, and resources as a community to meet a salient need.

We operate at two locations, our main headquarters in Star and a pantry in Emmett at the Gem County Recovery Community Center.

Your Community Food Bank

Originally founded as Star Outreach, Neighbors Helping Neighbors in 2008, the Star Food Bank serves the communities of Star, Eagle, Middleton and Emmett with a twice weekly food pantry. Since 2020, we have increased over 40% each year in the number of children, seniors and adults served each month.

Until 2023, we also operated a variety of outreaches to serve other basic needs including clothing and summer lunches for the children.


Through our partnership with the Idaho Foodbank and Feeding America, we have the opportunity to "rescue" food from 9 grocery stores in Ada County each week. These donations comprise the bulk of the food we distribute to our patrons but do not comprise the totality of what is received.


Additionally, our SOFT-T (or Star Outreach Food Tote Team) members donated 11,815 pounds of food and we were blessed to have multiple one time donations and regular food drives held by local churches, businesses and civic groups which comprised of another 14,000+ pounds of non-perishable food items.
